A 1 hour interactive plant tour designed to educate about the manufacturing processes involved in making quality Cast Stone.

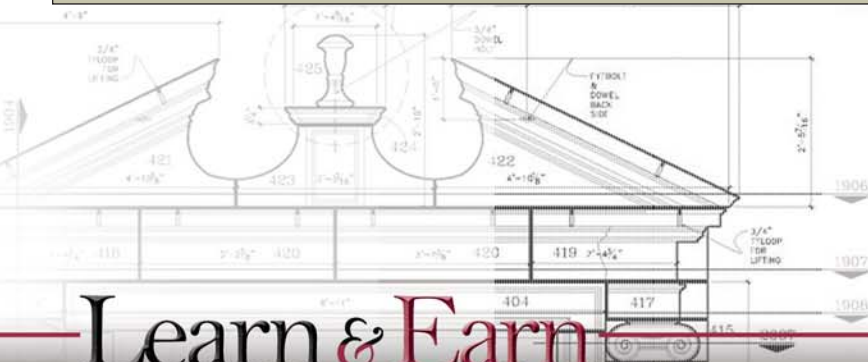
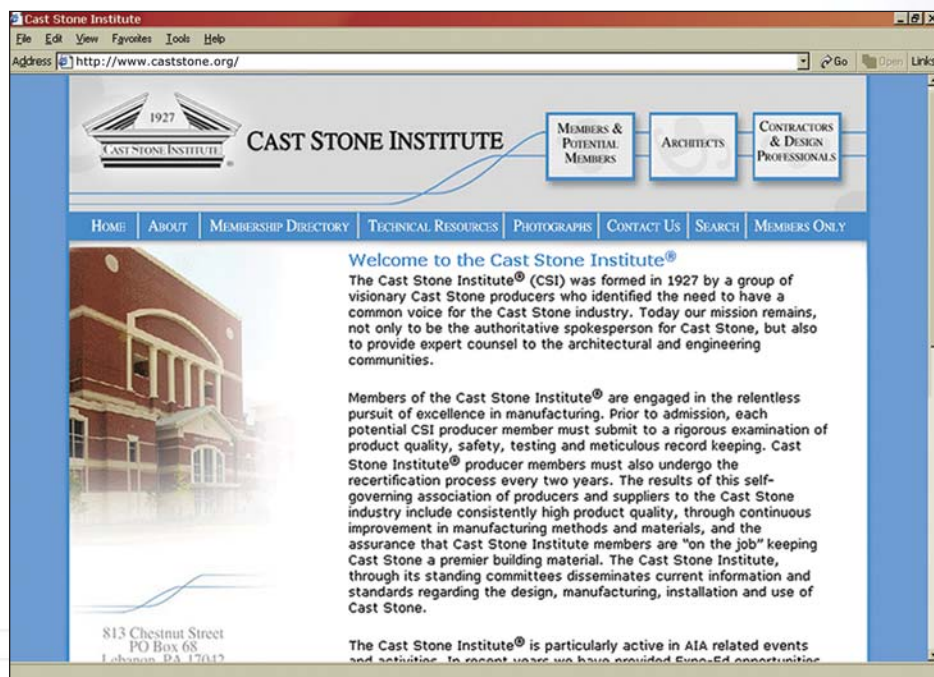
LEARNING OBJECTIVE
